

(-) **Racial Characteristics:**

Of the people living in this area in between 2005-2009, **86.18%** are White, **4.33%** are African American, **11.57%** are Hispanic, **2.27%** are Asian, **0.02%** are either Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander, **0.14%** are American Indian or Alaskan Native, **5.41%** are of "some other race" and **1.65%** are of two or more races. In the table below, the percentage of the population that each segment represents in the report area is compared to the percent it represents in the state.

Between 2000 and 2005-2009, the White population changed by **4.36%**, the African American population by **66.29%**, and Asian population by **46.66%**. The number of Hispanics will change by **59.18%**.

(-) Incomes:

The median household income for the study area **ranged from \$47,283 to \$59,070**, compared to a state median of **\$49,737**, as estimated for 2005-2009 by the Census' American Community Survey.

The number of households divided by income categories is shown in the Annual Income Category table. In 2009, **45.43%** of households in the study area had an annual income of less than \$50,000, compared to **50.24%** of people in the state.

(-) Immigration:

Data from the U.S. Census Bureau for 2005-2009 indicate that **46,852** people or **6.76%** of the population living in this area were "foreign born". Census defines foreign born as anyone who is not a U.S. citizen at birth. This area is located in Pennsylvania, which, according to the Department of Homeland Security, was home to **24,105** people who were granted Legal Permanent Residence status in 2009. Those LPRs, or "green cards", represent **2.14%** of green cards issued in the nation that year.

(-) Families and Households:

The composition of the **182,151** families who reside in the study area is shown in the table below. Families are groups of related people who live together, whereas households refer to the person or group of people living in any one housing unit. Generally, households that do not contain a family are made up of unrelated people living together (eg, roommates) or people living alone. While it is possible for two families to share a household, the difference between the number of households and the number of families in an area shows, approximately, the number of non-family households in a place.

(-) Tenure:

Across the area, an estimated **73.64%** or **195,312** households owned their home between 2005-2009. The average size of a household in this area **ranged from 2.44 to 2.55** between 2005-2009, as compared to the average household size for the county and the state, **2.55 (Northampton), 2.44 (Carbon), 2.52 (Lehigh)** and **2.46 (Pennsylvania)** respectively.
