## (-) Incomes:

The median household income for the study area was **\$54,934**, compared to a state median of **\$68,981**, as estimated for 2005-2009 by the Census' American Community Survey.

## (-) Immigration:

Data from the U.S. Census Bureau for 2005-2009 indicate that **39,241** people or **14.53%** of the population living in this area were "foreign born". Census defines foreign born as anyone who is not a U.S. citizen at birth. This area is

located in New Jersey, which, according to the Department of Homeland Security, was home to **58,879** people who were granted Legal Permanent Residence status in 2009. Those LPRs, or "green cards", represent **4.88%** of green cards issued in the nation that year.

### (-) Endnotes:

Calculations presented here were performed by staff at The Reinvestment Fund and are based on public and proprietary data sources that have been licensed for use in PolicyMap.

Depending on the type of size of the area selected for this report, the above values capture data for the block groups, tracts, counties, etc, in which at least 50% of their areas are contained. If this report is run for a zip code, some data will be unavailable, as zip code values for some topics are not available through the Census.

The source of crime data in the tables presented here is Federal Bureau of Investigation's Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Program, which compiles standardized incident reports from local law enforcement agencies in order to produce reliable, uniform, and national crime data. The UCR Program collects data on known offenses and persons arrested by law enforcement agencies. Crime data in this report is not summed or aggregated, but rather listed for each of the complete areas within the study area for which crime is reported.
