

(-) Immigration:

Data from the U.S. Census Bureau for 2005-2009 indicate that **23,520** people or **4.44%** of the population living in this area were "foreign born". Census defines foreign born as anyone who is not a U.S. citizen at birth. This area is located in Pennsylvania, which, according to the Department of Homeland Security, was home to **24,105** people who were granted Legal Permanent Residence status in 2009. Those LPRs, or "green cards", represent **2.14%** of green cards issued in the nation that year.

(-) Families and Households:
