### (-) Racial Characteristics:

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## (-) Incomes:

The median household income for the study area was **\$42,357**, compared to a state median of **\$49,737**, as estimated for 2005-2009 by the Census' American Community Survey.

### (-) Immigration:

Data from the U.S. Census Bureau for 2005-2009 indicate that **17,799** people or **3.24%** of the population living in this area were "foreign born". Census defines foreign born as anyone who is not a U.S. citizen at birth. This area is located in Pennsylvania, which, according to the Department of Homeland Security, was home to **24,105** people who were granted Legal Permanent Residence status in 2009. Those LPRs, or "green cards", represent **2.14%** of green cards issued in the nation that year.

## (-) Housing Type:

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### (-) Tenure:

### (-) Endnotes:

Calculations presented here were performed by staff at The Reinvestment Fund and are based on public and proprietary data sources that have been licensed for use in PolicyMap.
