





A lofted design upon entry from the front door offers beautiful aesthetics.

The **open floor plan** provides ample space for a lounging area and dining area just off the kitchen.





A first-floor bedroom allows each home to age with the home-owner.

Two additional bedrooms upstairs with large closets make these homes ideal for young families.



This home considers space usage in maximizing building cost efficiency. We provide a useful large walk-in pantry and save on costly cabinetry.





A second-floor open space is ideal for a children's play room, a home office, or a lounge area.



Single-source heating and cooling (left) combines with an innovative circulation system to heat or cool the entire home on extremely low wattage, projecting a \$400 annual cost to heat and cool the home.

**Internal fans** (vent in photo on left) distribute heat and cooling into the bedrooms.



A filtered passive air inlet, which can be opened or closed, combines with bathroom fans that are programmed to run full time at an energy efficient optimal speed that is specific to the measurements of this home, to continually exchange the fresh air throughout the home.

Low-flow faucets and shower heads throughout the home will reduce monthly city water bills and have a positive impact on monthly hot water heating bill.

**Energy Star Appliances** throughout the home result in an estimated monthly electric and heating bill of \$100.

**Marathon Electric Water Heater** is the most efficient electric water heater on the market. The **expansion tank** eliminates any hammering sounds in water pipes.



The foundation is insulated with extruded polystyrene to slow heat loss through the floor during winter months.

10 inch exterior walls (right) are filled with spray foam to provide superior insulation for more efficient heating and cooling, with the added benefit of dampening outside noise.


