



Older Adults Have Made Tremendous Financial Gains over the Past Generation


Share of Individuals with Family Incomes below the Federal Poverty Level by Age, 1966-2014


A New Poverty Measure that Accounts for Health Care Spending Better Reflects Financial Need at Older Ages

Older Adults Age 85+ and Those with Limited Education Are Especially Likely to Have Inadequate Income


Share of Workers with Incomes below 125% of the Official Federal Poverty Line, 2013

Share of Workers with Incomes below 125% of the Official Federal Poverty Line, 2013



Share of Workers with Incomes below 125% of the Official Federal Poverty Line, 2013





Social Security Is a Crucial Source of Income for Low-Income Older Americans


Distribution of Income Sources by Family Income Relative to the Federal Poverty Level, Ages 65+, 2013

Distribution of Household Spending by Income Relative to the Federal Poverty Level, Ages 65+, 2013



Housing Costs as a Share of Family Income by Housing Tenure, Ages 65+, 2013


