

## **CURE Travel Information**

### **Providence Airport**

TF Green Airport serves Providence. It is a 15-20 minute taxi ride (\$30-\$35) from the airport to the Biltmore Hotel or the campus of Brown University.

Every hour on the hour, a shared ride shuttle (\$11.77) departs the airport, arriving at the Biltmore at 22 past the hour and ½ block from the conference venue at 27 past the hour. More information is here: <http://www.airporttaxiri.com/shuttles/providence-shuttle>

### **Providence Train Station (Amtrak and MBTA Commuter Rail)**

The train station is a 5-10 walk to the Biltmore Hotel and a 10-15 minute walk to Brown University. Exit the train station in the downtown Providence direction for both destinations. See the enclosed map for details. Plentiful taxis are also available.

### **Boston Logan Airport**

Boston Logan airport is about 50 miles away from Providence and is a 1 hour drive in light traffic.

Without a car, probably the easiest way to get to Providence is to take a train from South Station. The free Silver Line bus runs frequently and picks up outside all terminals. It runs directly into South Station (about 20 minutes). A taxi takes about 10 minutes and costs about \$25. From South Station, an Amtrak train takes 35-45 minutes (\$15-\$45) while the MBTA commuter rail train (\$10.50) takes 60-75 minutes. Buy tickets before boarding the train. Train schedules vary throughout the day.

Peter Pan runs direct buses to downtown Providence (with 2-3 stops) for \$26 but they are not very comfortable nor reliable. Tickets are available online at <http://peterpanbus.com/>.

A taxi would cost about \$250 and may be difficult to procure.

You can also book a shuttle for \$100-\$125 per person.

### **Travel between the Biltmore Hotel and Brown University**
